OUR LEARNING

In Reception... Reception had some egg-citing visitors arrive in their classroom this week; 24 eggs! We are very excited to take care of the eggs and observe them closely in the incubator until it is time for them to hatch. We have enjoyed learning about the life cycle of chicks, what they need and how to look after them safely.

In Year 1... The children in Year 1 have made a fantastic start to the Summer term! In PE, we have been practising our ball skills in small groups, passing balls in different ways. In Science we have been looking at different leaves and comparing them and in Maths we have been working out related number facts using Unifix Cubes to help us! Well done Year 1!

In Year 2... Year 2 have settled back in well and have worked extremely hard all week. We loved our first Forest School session on Wednesday. In Science, we have enjoyed recalling prior learning from Year One; we identified the parts of plants and trees. In Geography, we have learnt about South America and located this on a map.

In Year 3... Year 3 have had a very busy first back after Easter. In English, we have started looking at our new book 'The Tin Forrest'. In Maths, we have been busy learning about unit and non-unit fractions and in Geography, we've been finding out interesting facts about rivers.

In Year 4... This week Year 4 have enjoyed exploring a new text in English, tackled Fractions in Maths and identified the differences between states of matter in Science. We also loved taking part in our first swimming session!

In Year 5... Year 5 have had a great first week back. We have continued our learning around fractions in Maths and in English, we have dived into our new text called 'The Hunter'.

In Year 6... Year 6 definitely deserve their weekend after such a busy first week back! We have written up some excellent setting descriptions as if we were on Ernest Shackleton's journey and have explored more of geometry in Maths, looking at coordinates, how to find internal angles in regular shapes, parts of a circle and finding missing angles.
