OUR LEARNING

In Reception...This week, Reception have been very excited to start their Phase 3 learning in Phonics. We have been blown away by 'Trigraphs' (three letters, one sound). We have also been learning about different types of whales linked to our literacy book 'The Storm Whale'. Our favourite so far is the Beluga Whale!

In Year 1... The children have made a fantastic start to the new year! They have loved reading their new English book, 'Do Not Enter the Zoo' and making wanted posters for 'Squirgal' the monster, who made a mess in our classroom! We have also begun our new History topic all about significant people. Well done Year 1!

In Year 2...We have described the characters and sequenced the events in our new English book 'Little Red Riding Hood'. In Maths, we are working extremely hard on subtracting a one-digit number from a two-digit number. In Science, we have learnt about how different materials can be used for the same object and we understand why this is done based on the properties of each material.

In Year 3... Year 3 have been investigating what a 'Stew' is. They created tally and bar charts showing their favourite vegetables. They learnt how to peel and chop the vegetables and created a delicious Stew!





In Year 4... This week in Year 4, we have had our first Forest School lesson. The children gave themselves Forest Names and made friendship bracelets. They then explored the "forest area" and experimented with branches.

In Year 5... In PHSE, Year 5 have started to learn about ways in which we can safely help if there is an accident or emergency. Using resources from St. Johns Ambulance, we started with asthma and the potential triggers of an asthma attack. We went on to create our own pair of Lungs. Year 5 labelled the bronchus, bronchioles and alveoli.

In Year 6... This week, Year 6 have been working more on long division and applying this to tricky questions. We have also looked at mathematical problems which involve all four operations, so we are definitely ready for a rest over the weekend!
