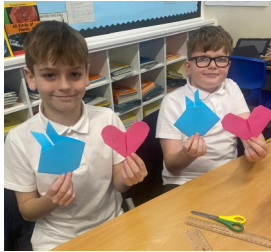

OUR LEARNING

In Reception... Reception have had a very busy and exciting week! We have completed our learning all about penguins and can now name six different species: Adélie, Emperor, Chinstrap, Humboldt, Rockhopper and Snares penguins. The children have loved writing their own fact files and sharing what they have learned about each species. Alongside our penguin work, we have also been busy taking part in activities linked to Safer Internet Day, Lunar New Year and Children's Mental Health Week. In Year 1... What a fun final week of the half-term Year 1 have had! From learning about how to stay safe online for Safer Internet Day, to taking part in a dance for Lunar New Year, we simply haven't stopped! In our classroom we have been focusing on Children's Mental Health Week, considering what places are special to us. In Maths, we have been learning about the greater and less than symbols. In English, we have written letters from the perspective of Hermelin. We have also completed our learning about the Great Fire of London in History and considered what changed after the fire. Have a lovely half-term break!

In Year 2... Year 2 have had another brilliant week! In English, we created our own set of instructions about how to build a home for a Bog Baby. We made our own Bog Baby homes and then discovered lots of mini Bog Babies in our classroom for us to care for! Our writing has been incredible this week and Miss Karalius has been so proud of us! In Maths, we are learning how use arrays to represent multiplication facts.
