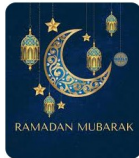
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On Sunday 10th March, Muslims around the globe began observing the holy month of Ramadan, a period of deep spiritual reflection and fasting that takes place every

# OUR LEARNING

**In Reception...** Reception have had a fun-tastic week! In Maths, we have been creating staircase patterns using different resources such as numicon, cuisenaire rods and large bricks! We enjoyed hiding a piece from the pattern and working in pairs, using our imaginary number line, to work out which piece was missing. Well done Reception, you make Miss Horton and Mrs Williams beam with pride every day!

**In Year 1...** This week in Year 1, we have loved learning about bridging through 10 in our Maths lessons! We also enjoyed a visit from Hamza's Mum, who told us all about Ramadan! In Science, we have been considering the changes of Winter into Spring and have been looking for any early signs of the change of seasons.

**In Year 2...** Year 2 have had an amazing week! In Geography, we have enjoyed learning about Africa and can describe the location of this continent using geographical vocabulary. In Music, we have explored the tempo and dynamics of different songs. In English, we have moved onto our new story 'Jim and the Beanstalk' and have enjoyed making predictions about what this book will be about.

**In Year 3...** In Year 3 this week we have been learning to use scaling in Maths by making numbers ten times bigger and ten times smaller to find the answers. In Science, we have created some very informative end points about rocks and soils. We used the character strengths from My Happy Mind to help us describe the robot in our story, 'Robot and the Bluebird'.

**In Year 4...** This week, Year 4 have blown us away with the diaries they have written in English. They have used beautiful vocabulary and new skills such as fronted adverbials to bring their diaries to life and we loved reading them. We also enjoyed a visit from Mark and Pam, from the local church, who explored Christian attitudes towards food and kindly brought us some delicious samples to try!

**In Year 5...** Year 5 have had their seventh swimming lesson. This week the focus was water safety. We wore clothes in the pool to replicate an unexpected fall into water.

All three teachers have commented on our positive behaviour and attitude.



**In Year 6...** This week, Year 6 have been focussing on statistics in Maths. We have been looking at and drawing our own line graphs, interpreting tricky pie charts including percentages and also learning how to find the mean average of a group of numbers. Another busy week in Year 6!
