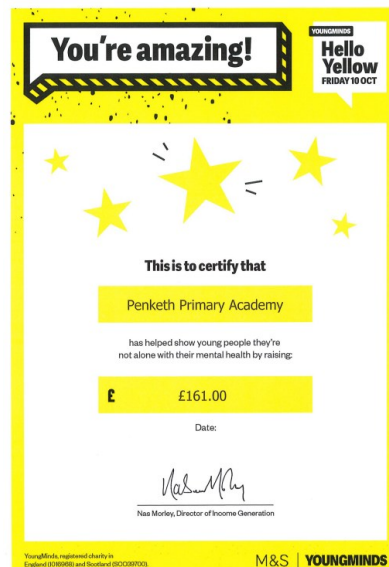

In Reception... Reception made us so proud in the Harvest Assembly on Thursday morning! They sang their little hearts out and joined in beautifully. We have had a very busy week, learning about Rosa Parks for Black History Month. We have also been practising our sound, talk and blending with our new phonemes, h,b,f and l! We hope you have a wonderful Autumn half-term break Reception!

In Year 1... What a fantastic week to finish our first half-term in Year 1! In Forest School, the children enjoyed lighting a fire and eating brioche buns. In English, we have finished our Old Bear stories; the children are very proud of the work they have produced! In Maths, we have begun to look at how to write an addition sentence. In Computing, we have considered people who we trust when we feel worried about something online. We were also so proud when we performed our Harvest Assembly for lots of our grown ups! Thank you to everyone who came to watch, we had so much fun!

In Year 2... This week in Maths, we have learnt that addition is commutative and enjoyed recalling number bonds to 10. In English, we have analysed our class text and picked out key writing features that we are going to include in our own pieces. In History, we have learnt about the life of Mary Seacole and discovered some of her amazing achievements. We loved performing our Harvest Assembly to you all - it was so much fun!

In Year 3... This week in Year 3, we have worked incredibly hard and made a great start to our assessments; well done Year 3! In English, we have created our trap explanations which have been so lovely to read! We have consolidated our spelling work in this week's spelling lessons and worked hard to remember the rule rhymes. In Spanish, we have learnt about counting in Spanish and worked hard as a team to beat Miss Banford. We enjoyed performing in our Harvest Festival and sang beautifully. Have a lovely break!

In Year 4... Already a half term completed! This week we have been creating double page spreads about digestion, learning about Roman numerals and negative numbers.
