OUR LEARNING

In Reception...This week, Reception have been very busy keeping the school grounds tidy. On Wednesday, we collected litter and created posters. We have also been enjoying our new book, 'The Storm Whale in Winter' and made our very own igloos!

In Year 1... This week, Year 1 have been introduced to place value charts in Maths. We have been making different 'teen' numbers using this chart. In English, we have been retelling the story 'Do Not Enter the Monster Zoo' and have been including words using the '-ed' suffix! In History, we have begun to learn about the life of Queen Elizabeth II.

In Year 2...Year 2 have worked extremely hard this week. In English, we have retold the story of Little Red Riding Hood using lots of amazing story language to make our writing even better. In Maths, we have subtracted multiples of 10 from two digit numbers. In Art, we have started to create our own 'Land Sculptures' inspired by Andy Goldsworthy.

In Year 3... This week we have been celebrating our character strengths in our Happy Mind work. Some people have earned their pen licences and have put their pens to good use writing the sequel to the 'Elves and the Shoemaker'. In History, we have been finding out about the major achievements of the Ancient Sumerians.
