

# OUR LEARNING

**In Reception...** Reception have had a very busy and exciting week! We have thoroughly enjoyed getting stuck into our new Literacy text, 'Little Red'. The children have been busy writing speech bubbles, creating their own 'Little Red' puppets, and even making wolf paw prints in the playdough area, bringing the story to life through their play and creativity. In Maths, we have been developing our understanding of spatial vocabulary, using it to describe the movements of the Bee-Bots as they travelled around. During our My Happy Mind session, we focused on active listening and learned the three important steps to be a good listener. Well done, Reception - you have all worked incredibly hard this week!

**In Year 1...** This week, Year 1 have loved finishing their retellings of 'Where the Wild Things Are'. We have been so impressed with their choice of vocabulary! Maths has been tricky this week; we have been bridging through 10 to complete different additions! In Geography, we explored the physical and human features of English, whilst in RE, we made lists of all the things we would need for a baptism and enjoyed looking at photos of a baptism that Miss Karalius had attended at the weekend! In Science, we learnt about daylight hours, and how the amount of daylight hours changed within the different seasons of the year. Well done Year 1, another super week!

**In Year 2...** Year 2 have enjoyed looking at different coins and found that different combinations can make the same amount. Our own versions of 'Grandad's Island' are now complete and they are amazing! In Geography, we learnt about the continent of Africa and identified some key features and used atlases to locate it on a map. In RE, we discussed why Christians may go to church.

**In Year 3...** This week in Year 3, we have been learning about division and using our number facts to help solve questions! In Reading, we have been focusing on a book called 'Hello Universe' which follows a deaf boy and the struggles he faces. We have enjoyed learning about this and had some brilliant conversations around the subject of disabilities. In English, we finished our transformation narratives and have started our next text 'It Fell From The Sky'. We have made some informed predictions about this story and are looking forward to finding out more. In RE, we have learnt about the First Pentecost and how Christians can live a 'fruitful' life.

**In Year 4...** This week we have begun counting down the sleeps until Robinwood! Just a reminder there will be a drop in session on Monday 23rd March to answer any questions or discuss any concerns. In Maths we have WOWED Mrs Clarke with our written multiplication, using the grid method, expanded multiplication and finally short multiplication. The time spent learning times tables is definitely paying off! In Science, we have been learning how to use classification keys to answer scientific questions about different types of animals and in PE we have loved playing table tennis using the new equipment. Finally, we enjoyed coming to school in our own clothes and having an extra playtime as some of the children in our class used their World Book Day prizes!

**In Year 5...** This week, Year 5 have worked incredibly hard in Maths exploring mixed numbers and improper fractions. It's a tricky concept but Miss Silver has been very proud of the children's resilience and their commitment to learning. We have also written our character narratives based on our class text 'The Promise' and have challenged ourselves to use ambitious vocabulary, a range of cohesive devices and some fantastic descriptions to really bring our stories to life! Forest School was a highlight of our week and we are really looking forward to next week as we will be building and lighting our own fires!

**In Year 6...** This week in Year 6 has been full of energy, enthusiasm and thoughtful learning. In PHSE, the children took part in a lively debate, sharing their opinions and listening to the views of others, showing empathy and understanding. In Maths, we have been working hard on reasoning and problem-solving with decimals. The children have been challenged to explain their thinking clearly, tackle multi-step problems, and apply their knowledge in different contexts. Their perseverance and determination have been fantastic to see, and they are growing in both confidence and accuracy.
