We have been busy writing our favourite things about our school to share with our new Reception children who will start in September. Have a look at the photographs to see what we like to do! We have also thoroughly enjoyed our treat day for our attendance and had lots of fun with Year 1 and 2! We hope all of our Reception families have a wonderful half-term break.



**In Year 1...** This week, Year 1 have completed their final art work, creating their own wildflower meadows using different materials! The children have also been writing their own setting descriptions of the island from our story in English. We were very impressed with their choice of vocabulary!





**In Year 3...** This week Year 3 have written some very persuasive letters to the Warrington Guardian about how we all need to do our bit to protect our planet and cut down plastic pollution. They have been shopkeepers and customers working out change from £1 and £5. They have ended the half term by producing their final printing based on a fossil. A super end to the half term!

In Year 5...Year 5 have had a very productive week! We have created persuasive leaflets about elephant conservation using a range of devices including strong arguments, rhetorical questions and emotive language.
