## OUR LEARNING

In Reception...This week in Reception, we have loved diving into our new story *Stanley's Stick*. The children have been using their wonderful imaginations to think about all the things their own special sticks could become, and they produced some fantastic creative writing to go with their ideas! We've also been getting into the festive spirit by decorating Christmas baubles for our classroom tree. The children were very proud of their sparkly creations, and our tree has never looked brighter. To finish the week, excitement has been building as we practise for our Nativity performances. The children are working so hard and can't wait to share their songs and acting with you next week!

In Year 1...It has been another fun-filled week in Year 1. We are now busy practising our KS1 Nativity with our friends in Year 2; we are doing well at remembering our lines and actions for the whole show! In English, we have been retelling the story of Rapunzel in four different parts. We have been working really hard to remember to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops for every sentence. In Maths, we have been working out subtractions from 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10, using counters to support us. In our RE lesson this week, we considered who was important in the Nativity story and why. We are looking forward to more exciting learning next week!

In Year 2...Year 2 have enjoyed practising our songs for the Nativity and are doing an amazing job at learning our lines! In English, we looked at the different writing features that are used within our class text, to help us to understand what we can include in our own setting descriptions. In Maths, we have recalled number bonds to 10 and used them to find related facts within 20. In Science, we learnt about and described a range of different habitats. In RE, we learnt about why Advent is an important time for Christians and what the candles on an advent wreath represent.

In Year 3... This week in Year 3, we have written our Fable Narratives all about Fox and Magpie! We have come up with some brilliant ideas and focused on including prepositions, conjunctions, alliteration and direct speech! In Maths, we have been focusing on adding 3-digit numbers with ones and tens. We have used bead strings and number lines to help support our learning, especially when solving written questions. In Music, we used boom whackers to help our understanding on pitch and rhythm. We have also been learning all about Jesus, his disciples and different parables from the Bible.

**In Year 4...** Another busy week for Year 4 with possessive apostrophes, silent 'b's and levers and linkages! The children are continuing to work hard on their writing using our lovely book 'Leaf' to write an outsider narrative. They have been investigating different strategies for addition and subtraction including scaling, partitioning, complements, related facts and bar models. In our Science lesson, they learnt how pitch works and are doing a great job rehearsing our Christmas play!

In Year 5...Alongside Bikeability, Year 5 have had a very busy week! We have continued to look at a variety of mental strategies for addition and subtraction and we have been getting ready to start our setting narrative based on our book 'FaRTHER' next week. In Science, we learned the life spans of different species and created a bar chart to represent this. We have also started preparing for our Christmas performance!

In Year 6...Year 6 have had a big writing focus this week, creating setting descriptions with a flashback narrative, based on our class text 'A Story Like the Wind'. On Monday, they visited Crucial Crew, where they took part in interactive workshops covering topics, such as fire and road safety, preparing them for life in and beyond school.
