OUR LEARNING

In Reception... The children have been enjoying the sunshine this week. We have been finding minibeasts and creating little houses for them in our outdoor area. In Literacy we have been reading our non-fiction text 'Seed to Plant' and have been identifying and labelling the life cycle of a plant at each of its four stages. In Maths, we have been working hard on number bonds to 10 using a ten frame to support our understanding!

In Year 1... This week the children have been working hard on their writing in English. We have looked at using the prefix un- in lots of different words, and used these words in our writing linked to Toys in Space. In Maths, we have been identifying different 3D shapes. We have also started our new Science topic all about plants. We began by looking at the different parts of a flower and what their role is to help a flower survive.

In Year 2... Year 2 have been sequencing the events in our story, 'Jim and the Beanstalk', and are beginning to think about how they could rewrite it with an alternative ending. In Maths, we have learnt about fractions and found a half, a quarter and a third of different shapes. In Science, we identified different types of seeds and described their properties. In Forest School, we made clay sculptures and enjoyed exploring. We had an amazing time in the sunshine!

In Year 3... This week the children have worked hard in Maths to use a number line and short division method to solve problems. In English we focused on creating the perfect speech sandwich, with all of the components that made our dialogue brilliant, and wrote amazing opening paragraphs for our new text. In RE, we have been learning about Dharma within Hinduism and different places people pray. We completed our first swimming lesson, and played cricket in the sunshine!

In Year 4... What a lovely week! The sun is shining and Year 4 are working very hard. This week we have been learning more about rainforests and using the apostrophe for possession to organize what we would take with us on a rainforest expedition. We have been learning about factors and products in Maths, creating factor bugs and factor rainbows. In our Happy Mind session we have been practicing our attitude to gratitude, thinking about what we are thankful for and how saying thank you make us and others feel.

In Year 5... This week, we have been learning about the order of the planets and their orbital paths - see if we can remember which ones are nearest and closest to the sun! In English, we have been planning to write a letter to Warrington Borough Council about helping the environment. In Maths, we have learnt how to convert fractions to decimals and this learning will continue next week.

In Year 6... Y6 have really blown us away! They have revised several concepts in Maths, including; negative numbers, multiplication and division and converting between fractions and decimals. They have also dedicated time to Reading Plus and reading comprehensions. They even marked a paper I had completed to check for any careless errors! We are all so very proud of them all.
