OUR LEARNING

In Reception... This week in Reception, we have been having fun exploring a new way to practise our handwriting! Using 'flipper flappers' and some energetic dance moves, we have been strengthening our muscles and improving coordination while learning. In Literacy, we have been reading the non-fiction book 'Hello Penguin' and discovering fascinating facts about penguins. Ask us what a baby penguin is called - we'll be excited to tell you! In *MyHappyMind*, we focused on gratitude and our unique superpower character strengths. We enjoyed discussing how everyone has different superpowers that make us special and one-of-a-kind. In Maths, we have been hiding 'Froggy' and using spatial vocabulary to describe where to find him!

In Year 1... We have had another fun week in Year 1! In Art, we created paintings based on the works of Pieter Bruegel. We used water colours as the background, and painted trees in the foreground. In Maths, we have been completing missing number sequences up to 20, as well as finding one more and one less to 20. In our History work, we considered what factors caused the Great Fire of London to spread so quickly across the city. We were shocked to learn that back in 1666, there was no fire brigade to help!

In Year 2... Year 2 have worked so hard on their addition and subtraction unit and have listened incredibly well. They have presented their working out beautifully! In English, we have written our own versions of 'The Bog Baby' story and created some amazing illustrations too! In PSHE, we discussed the things that we use money for and thought about how we can get our own money. In PE, we worked on our jumping and landing skills!

In Year 3... This week in Year 3, we have worked hard in our Maths lessons learning our times tables and focusing on the commutative and inverse laws! In English, we have gathered information about waterfalls and rivers and analysed example text in preparation for writing our information leaflets, using sentences containing technical vocabulary. In Reading, we have thoroughly enjoyed our text, 'The Anthology of Intriguing Animals' and learning all about the fabulous creatures on our earth!

In Year 4... This week has, once again, been very busy in Year 4. We started the week by receiving a very urgent letter from the Ancient Guild of Monster Hunters, requesting our help in creating some new guides to hunting monsters as theirs had been lost in a fire. Of course we agreed to help! Our focus in Maths continues to be times tables and we are blowing Mrs Clarke's socks off with our quick recall of facts! In History, we have been learning all about the rebel Boudicca and her fight against the Romans and in Science, we have continued to create electrical circuits, but this week we included a switch so we could control when the bulb was lit.

In Year 5... This week, Year 5 have worked incredibly hard in Maths, looking at short division, impressing our teachers yet again with our resilience and perseverance. We have loved welcoming Miss Silver back and showing her how much we have matured! In Art, we have looked at Pointillism and learnt about the significance of 'The Night of Power' for Muslims in RE.

In Year 6... In Maths, the children have been adding and subtracting fractions, including mixed number fractions, different denominators and simplifying their answers. We have focused on using clear methods, checking for lowest common multiple denominators, and explaining our reasoning to deepen our understanding. In English, we explored how authors create vivid settings and characters by carefully choosing their words. The class practised using synonyms and antonyms to add contrast and cohesion to their descriptions, helping their writing flow more smoothly while making details more engaging for the reader. We were impressed by the thoughtful vocabulary choices many pupils made in their independent writing.
