OUR LEARNING

In Reception...We are currently learning about life cycles and have been observing some eggs hatch into chicks this week! The children have been developing their scientific observation skills and are able to identify different body parts of the chicks e.g. feathers and beaks. They have also developed

their understanding of the responsibilities that come with caring for living things, such as ensuring the chicks are kept warm and learning to hold them gently. The children have had lots of fun naming the chicks and watching them grow!



In Year 1...What an exciting week Year 1 have had! From researching about how the Golden Gates arrived in Warrington, to comparing different plants in Science, we haven't stopped! As a treat, Year 1 loved meeting the chicks in Reception Class! In Year 2...In English we have moved onto our new story 'There's No Big Bad Wolf in this Story' and have enjoyed writing a character description. In Maths, we have found fractions of different amounts. In Forest School this week we made a fabric bookmark and created land art inspired by Andy Goldsworthy.

In Year 3... We have been very busy this week learning more about our book 'The Tin Forrest' in English. We learnt how to write instructions and follow them to create our own birds and trees made from tin foil.

In Year 4...Year 4 have worked very hard this week. In English, we have chosen, researched and complied a fact file about a forest animal. In Maths, we've learnt about geometry and angles and in DT we have had the exciting task of making a pneumatic mouth which actually opens and closes!

In Year 5....Year 5 have produced some really excellent writing this week. We reached the end of our focus text 'The Hunter' and have sectioned it ready to recreate our own versions. In Maths, we have continued to grapple with fractions, using our times tables has been key the key to finding the lowest common multiple. We have also started to explore how the earth moves in relation to the sun.
