OUR LEARNING

In Reception... Reception have enjoyed meeting 'Strut' our toy class chicken who introduced our new Literacy book, 'The Little Red Hen'. We have been writing speech bubbles, ordering pictures and making paper plate red hens! We've had lots of fun in the sunshine on the field this week and learning in our Outdoor Area. In Maths, we have been making part whole models using our knowledge of number bonds to 5 and 10. Well done Reception!

In Year 1... This week, Year 1 have been designing and making their own healthy sandwiches! The children have loved choosing their fillings and type of bread! In Maths, we have been subtracting a one-digit number from a two-digit number in different ways, including using tens frames and number lines. In Geography, we have learnt about Northern Ireland; we now know all about the four countries in the United Kingdom. In English, we have been writing about the Gingerbread Man, describing how he looks and how he acts in the story.

In Year 2...Year 2 have started their new story 'Jim and the Beanstalk' and are so excited to find out who Jim really is! In DT, we enjoyed tasting different kinds of soup in preparation for designing our own soup next week! In Maths, we have continued to look at money and can find different ways to make the same amount. In Geography, we have located North America on a map and learnt lots of interesting facts!

In English, we have been using persuasive techniques in preparation for our big write next week. In RE, we have been learning about the first Pentecost, and discussing how and why the Holy Spirit presented itself in the form of flames.
