OUR LEARNING

In Reception... Reception have been busy bees this week! We've been writing speech bubbles from 'Dom the Dragon', exploring partitioning 5 using our part-whole model, mixing primary colours, and making the most of the sunshine! We're also practising a special song for our Mother's Day Afternoon on Friday 13th at 2 PM - we can't wait to celebrate with you. Don't forget to check Tapestry for updates on your child's learning adventures!



In Year 1... This week, Year 1 have enjoyed lots of different activities. In Geography, we looked at the capital cities of each country in the UK, and identified significant landmarks from each place. In Maths, we have been adding by counting on, before moving onto addition word problems. In English this week, we have been writing character descriptions of The Wild Things, using different suffixes and conjunctions within our sentences. We have also loved celebrating World Book Day, read lots of books and took part in different reading activities across the day!

In Year 2... Year 2 have enjoyed identifying and naming the five different oceans. We used Atlases to recap our continent knowledge too! We have continued our division unit this week and learnt to divide by sharing into equal groups. In English, we have looked at a setting from the story and created fantastic descriptions, including lots of noun phrases and adverbs. In Music, we discussed how different types of music can make us feel and why this may be. We had a wonderful day on World Book Day and enjoyed listening to many different stories.

In Year 3... This week in Year 3, we have had lots of fun and have enjoyed the sunshine! In RE, we have been learning all about what gives us pride and different reasons we are proud of ourselves and each other. In PSHE, we have been learning about communities and advice we would give to someone who is new to a community. In Maths, we have been scaling in preparation for written multiplication next week! In English, we have been writing character descriptions, unpicking an example text to find lots of language and structure. We have enjoyed creating artwork using our collage skills. We have also completed our assessments. A big well done Year 3!

In Year 4... This week Year 4 started the week with the children creating some beautiful pieces of art work that will be used in the whole class PAN display (more details to follow). They all enjoyed drawing rainbows and bugs in Maths to help them work out the different factors of specific numbers. In DT, they have been introduced to 'pneumatics' and have been inflating balloons using empty washing up liquid bottles and in Geography they started to look at Greece. The highlight of the week was definitely WORLD BOOK DAY, coming to school in the pyjamas and sharing their love of books all day!

In Year 5... What a fun week year 5 have had! We absolutely LOVED forest school! We wish we could do it every day! We also really loved celebrating World Book Day and wearing our pyjamas. We did lots of fun activities like creating different objects that link to a book, and revealing them one by one to see if our friends could guess the book. We also joined in on a BBC live event called 'The Great Big Footy and Booky Quiz', where we saw lots of familiar famous faces. Alongside this, we have continued our assessments and worked towards writing out a character narrative based on the book 'The Promise'.

In Year 6... This week has been full of creativity and learning! In English, we have been planning our own documentary narratives, combining factual information and engaging storytelling. In Maths, we have been building our confidence with multiplying and dividing decimals, working hard to understand place value. We had a fantastic time celebrating World Book Day, working in groups to design imaginative reading dens, writing thoughtful book reviews, making our own bookmarks and finished the day with some cosy reading and a well deserved hot chocolate!
