OUR LEARNING

In Reception...Reception have had a super first week back! We have been learning about teen numbers in Maths and how to build them using numicon. In Literacy, we have been reading 'Naughty Bus'. The bus has been up to mischievous tricks in our classroom overnight! I wonder what the bus will get up to over the weekend..?

In Year 1...This week, Year 1 have been planting beans to observe how they grow in Science! We will be tracking their progress for the next few weeks. The children have also been considering how to make the world a kinder place in PSHE!

In Year 2...In Maths, we have been learning about time and are working extremely hard to tell the time in 5 minutes intervals. In PSHE, we have looked at different emotions and how to recognise these. Our Music lesson linked to this perfectly as we sang songs in different ways based on a given emotion. We then discussed how the pitch might change as a result. For example, how our voices would sound if we were feeling excited compared to if we were feeling sad.

In Year 3...Wow! Year 3 have absolutely blown my socks off this week with the mature and resilient way they have tackled the Year 3 summer tests. We are all very proud of them! In Science we have been learning about different light sources. In DT we have investigated shell structures using different types of packaging.

In Year 4...We have been learning about the Bible in RE and how important it is in guiding and supporting Christians throughout their lives. In Maths we have revisited bar charts, decimals and fractions - you may have seen our tweet! Tonight it is our first 'Maths Tutor Club' and all of Year 4 are welcome! A huge thank you to Mrs Sykes for helping us. Miss Silver continues to be poorly and we are all sending her all our love for a speedy recovery.

In Year 5...This week Year 5 have completed persuasive leaflets. I am blown away by the quality of what they have produced, but also the passion for animal conservation. We have also started our new text in English which we are excited to discover more about! In Science we have completed 'double page spreads' about all we know about Earth and Space! A busy but productive first week back.
